WHY DO YOU NEED A PART TIME IT MANAGER?

No dedicated IT Manager

- IT is managed part time by a non IT professional
- No expertise
- Distracted from their core role
- Reactive, not proactive
- IT viewed as a cost, not a gamechanger
- Your 3rd party IT provider is only as effective as their briefings/direction

Kinetics part time IT Manager

FLEXIBLE AND SCALABLE – BASED ON YOUR NEEDS

We start by identifying and documenting your IT needs, paying particular attention to:

- 1 Ensuring IT is structured and used according to best practice. (A large part of this is developing company policies and then measuring against them)
- 2 License management - renewal, reconciliation, optimisation and reporting
- 3 Vendor management and measurement
- 4 Project oversight, assessment, management and reporting.
- 5 Peer review, ensure IT is meeting internal user satisfaction benchmarks
- 6 IT Governance and strategy, roadmaps, project prioritisation
- 7 Needs assessment - often attending management meetings, proactive engagement throughout the organisation to determine opportunities for IT to refine processes and create efficiencies
- 8 Business continuity including risk plans and assessments, and SLA management
- 9 Reporting - monthly or quarterly reports suitable for CEO and board.
